Category I 

Two-axle vehicles with a height measured on the first axis of less than 1.3 m (motorcycles, passenger cars registered up to 5 seats, and light commercial vehicles).

Category II 

Vehicles with two or more axles and the height measurement on the first axis less than 1.3 m (vans, passenger cars with trailers, caravans with a height of 1.3 m on the front axle and light commercial vehicles with a trailer, caravan, two-axle vehicles such as vans vehicles without trailers, vehicles with a maximum permissible weight of up to 3,500 kg, and vehicles registered for the number of seats from 6 to 9).

Category III 

Vehicles with two or three axles and the height measurement on the first axis greater than 1.3 m (trucks with or without trailers, with a total of two or three axles, caravans with a height greater than 1.3 m on the front axle and vans with trailers or caravans with a total of three axles, buses without a trailer with two or three axles, vehicles with a maximum permissible mass exceeding 3,500 kg, vehicles registered more than 9 seats).

Category IV 

Vehicles with four or more axles and the height measurement on the first axis greater than 1.3 m (trucks with or without a trailer with four or more axles, with semi-tractors, buses, with or without a trailer with four or more axles, vans with trailers or caravans with four or more axles, vehicles with a maximum permissible mass exceeding 3.500kg, vehicles registered more than nine seats).

The process of performing tasks in a closed toll collection system shall be as follows:

At the entrance of the toll station the user enters the inbound lane, takes a magnetic card from encoder of magnetic cards, a ramp automatically raises after taking the card and allows the user to enter the motorway or expressway. At the exit toll station a cashier records the corresponding number of vehicles in the PC treasury, takes the magnetic card from the user and inserts the magnetic card in the magnetic card reader. The PC treasury determines the price that the user should pay on the basis of vehicles and the magnetic card. Treasurer of the PC cashier enters the type and amount of received payments or types in a free passage, to issue a bill from the PC cash registers (or confirmation of a free pass), the ramp is automatically rising after the checkout is completed.

In case of a magnetic card is unreadable by the magnetic card encoder at the exit station, the cashier must manually enter the output timing, the group of vehicles and the registration licence.

In the event of a power failure or system of toll collection of prints, the treasurer has to issue a bill from the block.

The process of performing tasks in an opened toll collection shall be as follows:

Upon arrival at the car payment, a cashier at PC cashier enters the corresponding vehicle group, type and amount of proceeds received payments or types in a free passage, to issue a bill from the cashier (or confirmation of a free pass), and the ramp automatically rises by a completed collection of vehicles released.

For vehicles exempted from payment the treasurer of the toll collection controls: the decision on release, the user identification card, vehicle registration number and based on the release, and PC cash register, enroll based on the release and registration of the vehicle.

In case of power failure or termination of cash in the open system for toll crosses the wrist charge via the toll ticket which is issued by a group of vehicles to customers who pay a toll, and free passes are recorded on the prescribed form.

Procedure of selling assets subscription

procedure of sale of license fees for the toll payment is done in two ways, namely:

1. Paying in cash
2. Payment through bank transfer

means the electronic subscription FEDA contactless cards that are sold at an appropriate price, while charging the same is done by the user. Sales and charging electronic FEDA contactless cards are done in cash at toll point at the box office at any cashier who does the work toll. Sales and filling FEDA contactless cards per account (Virmansko payment) shall charge an employee at the billing site. Authorized by the employee takes a certified copy of a receipt and forward the service of the Financial Department where it is control over the payment statements and invoicing services. Payments made by electronic means must be sealed and signed by the payer.

FEDA Electronic contactless card

at the toll bar fitted readers FEDA contactless cards at two heights (freight and passenger cars). User contactless card FEDA FEDA runs his proximity card so that it is possible to detect a contactless card reader FEDA, which is located at the toll lane. Card Reader takes the data from FEDA contactless cards and compares them with all the lists. When all data are verified, the transaction will be done by sending data on a central computer system. After a successful transaction ramp will open before the car. The ramp will remain open until the vehicle passes and leaves space inductive loops.

The group of vehicles excluded from paying tolls are included:

1. Vehicles of the Red Cross, under Article 19.paragraph.1.t.4. Law of the Red Cross, the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
2. Vehicles exempted under the contract by the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina concluded with international institutions,
3. vehicle breakdown assistance with the idea of identification cards, in case of intervention on the highway,
4. Vehicles of the Armed Forces of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
5. Vehicles disabled with 80% or more percent of physical disability.
6. Vehicles civil protection
7. Ambulances,
8. Vehicles of the Ministry of Interior,
9. Fire trucks
10. Vehicles that run of routine and winter maintenance of motorways and expressways,
11. and other vehicles are exempted from payment of tolls by the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
